CALAMANSI (LIME)

Calamansi (*Citrofortunella microcarpa*) grows natively in the Philippines. Its trees bear small, orange-like fruits, dark green foliage and white flowers. Despite its outer appearance and citrus-y fragrance, the fruit is sour, although the peel is sweet.

Prized for its fruit and ornamental value, calamansi is ubiquitous in traditional Filipino cuisine. It is used in various condiments, beverages, dishes, marinades and preserves, or even as an ingredient in Malaysian and Indonesian cuisines.
